The improvement program is proposed to include the limited use of herbicides and mechanical harvesting for aquatic plant control and watershed management for long term lake protection.

At the close of the hearing, the Hardwood Lake Improvement Board will make a decision on whether to proceed with the lake improvement project. 1. Is there a map or can one be made showing the designated areas that would be treated either with the herbicides or mechanical harvesting? Also the watershed management area.
2. Has there been a study of the high and low of water levels. Can anything be done to alter the current water level?
